Ms. Terri will let you know where to be to help decorate the trucks before the parade. Volunteers needed.

We would like all to ride and participate; brothers, sisters, moms and dads, if you do here are a few rules you need to know.

1. No costumes, wear jeans, Nutcracker T-shirt. If cold wear something under your jeans & shirt. Hats, scarves, & gloves OK
2. All MUST ride the truck. Bring blankets to sit upon with your family; they too must have a Nutcracker shirt.
3. Party Children dancers are the only ones walking in costume and passing out candy.
4. Do not throw candy from truck, or while walking. Bring your own basket, we will bring candy for you.
5. THE PARADE ENDS AT WEXLER AND MARKET, PLEASE PICK YOUR CHILD UP THERE, THE I.C.B.T. TEACHING STAFF CAN NOT WAIT WITH LOST OR FORGOTTEN CHILDREN. PICK THEM UP AS SOON AS OUR SECTION PASSES YOU, NOT AT THE END OF THE ENTIRE PARADE.
