## Class Notes

### Tap Shoes too big?

- A) put in an innersole
- B) wear socks
- C) punch an extra hole in the strap with a small nail and hammer

Check your shoes monthly to make sure the taps are smooth and there are no nails/screws sticking out. These simple measures prevent damage to our dance floors!

### --- Potty Break Problems! ---

To avoid disrupting class, please have your dancer use the bathroom just before class. Remind the little ones to flush and wash hands.

### Needed Items

Dancers use a lot of hair elastics and tissues. We ask that each student bring a box of tissues and a package of the heavier hair elastics to class this month.

### Late Pick Ups

Dancers must let teachers know if their parents are late and are not to wait downstairs for 30-45 minutes alone. Dancers are absolutely not to wait outside in the parking lot! We will wait with your child, but we ask that you call if you are going to be late. There is a fee if you are more than 30 minutes late, unless we are notified in advance.

### FALL BREAK:

Please know that we will be IN session during fall break. We may have to do some minor schedule changes during that week.
